



## Stowmarket Town Football Club COVID Statement of Intent

We welcome you to Greens Meadow, during this time where we face a different way of operating under COVID restrictions, Here's what to expect. We take our responsibility as a club very seriously and know you will feel the same, we ask that you follow the guidelines and instructions that will be given before and during the day.

- Entry to the club will be via the main club entrance not the usual turnstiles route
- On arrival you may have your Temperature taken this is for everyone's safety and we hope you will accept it in the spirit that it is meant.
- Should you feel unwell or present with symptoms prior to the game **please do not attend**. At any point during your time at Greens Meadow if you feel unwell please make this known and in the process isolate yourself as much as possible from everyone else, we have medical professionals on site and they will take care of you.
- Face coverings are mandatory inside the grounds from arrival to departure both inside the club and pitch side including Dugouts. **No Mask No Entry!**
- Stewards will create a safe passage for you and the team to enter & exit the field of play.
- Changing rooms will be available for team talks but will be limited to the starting 11 only, storing of kit bags & personal belongings will continue. Access will be restricted to a maximum number of personnel being allowed in at any one-time pre- and post-match in line with current Risk assessment. **FACE MASKS ARE TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES**
- Maintain good hand hygiene – use the sanitiser dispensers provided and avoid touching your face, or handles, railings etc. whenever possible.
- Please observe respiratory etiquette – always cover your mouth if needing to cough or sneeze. No spitting or mouth rinsing
- Avoid hugs, high-fives and any close contact with people who are not within your social bubble.
- We operate to the current social guidance rules, if we get a little excited and get to close please feel free to remind us, as we will do if we experience the same.
- We use the NHS track and trace system, and you will be required to use on arrival to Greens Meadow
